

GIVING FROM AN IRA

IRA owners age 70 ½ or over can make tax-free gifts directly from an IRA to InterVarsity. Each IRA owner can transfer up to a total of \$100,000 tax-free per year, directly from his or her IRA to InterVarsity and other charities with a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD)

Benefits

- QCDs are excluded from taxable income (therefore offer the same benefits as an itemized income tax charitable deduction).
- If you are taking Required Minimum Distributions (RMDs), QCDs can count toward satisfying your RMD without increasing your taxable income.
- Your gift supports the important work of InterVarsity with a tax-free gift.

How to Make a Qualified Charitable Distribution to InterVarsity

1. Contact your IRA custodian/administrator for their procedures. Tell them you want to initiate a Qualified Charitable Distribution directly to **InterVarsity Christian Fellowship, P.O. Box 7895 Madison, WI 53707-7895**.
2. To assure that your gift is credited to your account and applied to the specific InterVarsity ministry/ies you want it to support, be sure to notify us of these details by completing and mailing the enclosed letter, or by calling our Donation Services Department (toll-free 866-734-4823).

Important Tax Considerations When Making A Qualified Charitable Distribution

- If your IRA custodian will be mailing a check directly to InterVarsity, or to you to be forward to us, the envelope must be postmarked December 31 or earlier for your gift to be deductible for that tax year.
- If you will be writing a check to InterVarsity from a checkbook provided by your IRA custodian, mail your check to us not later than December 20 so we can deposit it by December 31 for your gift to be deductible for that tax year.
- If you are 70 ½ or older, still working, and are making deductible contributions to your IRA, check with your tax advisor before making a QCD.
